Thank you for wanting to help HSTV save more homeless animals. By being able to place animals in foster homes, we are able to pull more animals from high-intake, euthanasia shelters in the region and work towards no-kill in East Tennessee by 2025. Fosters are an integral part of rescue.

Please read and understand the following policies and procedures before committing to fostering.

1. All animals in the home must be above 6 months of age, altered and current on all vaccines:
Dogs: Rabies, DAPP, Bordatella, Heartworm. Cats: Rabies, FVRCP, Feline Leukemia, Combo Test
2. HSTV evaluates and vaccinates (age and size dependent) all animals appropriately prior to placement in foster, but cannot guarantee health or temperament. It's important to keep fosters separate from current animals at least for the first 10-14 days.
3. HSTV cannot be held responsible for any illness or injury that may occur to humans or animals in the home.
4. ALL foster animals remain property of HSTV and will be returned when requested or of age.
5. Fosters may be required to bring animals back to HSTV for routine vetting protocols and checkups.
6. I will follow all medical and other given instructions provided to me by HSTV.
7. Vet care will be provided by HSTV or our partner vet hospital. All illnesses must be reported IMMEDIATELY to HSTV for appropriate care. If taken to another vet without prior approval, no refund will be given for charges.
8. I understand that I cannot promise any particular animal to any adopter. All interested parties (including foster) must go through HSTV to complete an adoption application once the animal is returned to the adoption floor.
9. Foster coordinator will check in weekly via email or phone to check progress and follow up on medical needs. If any further questions or concerns arise, I will contact HSTV Foster Coordinator.
10. All equipment supplied to foster will be returned with the foster animal. Failure to do so may result in forfeiture of foster approval and actions of theft may be instituted.
11. While we strive to supply all items necessary to foster, fosters may need to purchase food items as we depend primarily on donation and could run low. A tax receipt can be supplied for any items used with an HSTV foster.
